The PSHS Dance Company is a firm believer in rewarding the talent and commitment of its members. The awards are designed to show appreciation for the hard work for all students but also to ensure that the awards reflect the correct level of commitment and participation. Students earn the awards through active involvement in the PSHS Dance Team.

- First Year: Dance Certificate: PSHS Dance Team members complete two consecutive semesters
- Second Year: Dance Letter: Dance Team members complete four consecutive semesters
- Third Year: Dance Medal: Dance Team members complete three semesters
- Four Year: Dancer Pin: Dance Team members complete four semesters

Additionally, students may earn:

- 4 Year Plaque – Dance Team member recognition in the following categories; dance skills/technique, leadership, & choreography.
- Georgia Nelson Dance Scholarship- is awarded to two Dance Team members who are Seniors, in an effort to help them further their dance education at the college and university levels.
- The highest award is earning the Graduate Sash which is given to Graduates of the PSHS Dance Team who have participated for a minimum of six semesters of Dance Team and must be a member in good standing. Attendance at all rehearsals and performances as well as having a positive attitude. There are some provisions for students who transferred from other schools, who entered the program late, or who have extenuating circumstances to earn their graduate sash.

These awards are provided through the PSHS Dance Company's fundraising funds: students are not charged for their letters, medals, sashes or awards.
